Scan and send your signed MTA to Tiny Earth in care of Jennifer Heinritz



Enter soil/culture/isolate information into the <u>Tiny Earth Database</u> (https://data.tinyearth.wisc.edu/). The database will assign each isolate an isolate number, which will become their unique ID.



Please fill out the isolate submission form found here. If you would like to request slants, you can do so in this form. After submitting the form, the Tiny Earth Chemistry Hub will contact you.



Streak your selected isolates onto slants and allow to grow. Label the slants with the isolate number given by the Tiny Earth Database. **Note: the Tiny Earth Chemistry Hub will not accept any risk group 2 organisms.**



Package your slants following directions in the <u>Packing Instructions</u>. The Tiny Earth Chemistry Hub will email you a shipping label.

Ship

Print and place packing slip inside the package and afix label to the outside of the shipping container. Call for a pickup (1-800-GOFEDEX, 1-800-463-3339) or drop off your package at a FedEx dropoff location. If you are calling for a pickup, press 1 or say "schedule a pickup" in the opening menu. They should not request any information other than the pickup address.
