Label/
Grow

Streak your selected isolates onto slants and allow to grow. Label the slants with the isolate number given by the Tiny Earth Database. **Note: the Tiny Earth Chemistry Hub will not accept any risk group 2 organisms.**

Package

Package your slants following directions in the [Packing Instructions](#). The Tiny Earth Chemistry Hub will email you a shipping label.

Ship

Print and place packing slip inside the package and affix label to the outside of the shipping container. Call for a pickup (1-800-GOFEDEX, 1-800-463-3339) or drop off your package at a FedEx dropoff location. If you are calling for a pickup, press 1 or say "schedule a pickup" in the opening menu. They should not request any information other than the pickup address.
